Nehemiah 6:15-7:3

Review

- How do you celebrate when you have finally completed a task that you have been working on for some time? Why do you think you respond in this way?
- Have there been times in your own life when you have faced a choice about how to respond to injustices, or threats to yourself and others?
- When you read this Bible passage, what particular verse or phrase stands out?

Remind

- How long had it taken to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem (v.15)?
- How did the surrounding nations respond when they heard that the work on the walls had been completed (v.16)?
- Why were the Nobles still writing letters to Tobiah (v.17-19)?
- Once the walls were rebuilt and gates put in place, who did Nehemiah appoint (v.1-2)?

Respond

- Nehemiah worked effectively against the plots around him. How can we be equally effective against things we feel are wrong?
- Nehemiah appointed 'gatekeepers, singers and Levites' (v.1). What role or activity do you seek to fulfill in the church?
- Nehemiah appointed Hanani and Hananiah because of their faithfulness to God, their fear of God and their watchfulness? What Godly attributes and characteristics are you seeking in your life?
